

DUTIES OF BOARD MEMBERS

Duty of Care: Board members are expected to actively participate in organizational planning and to make sound and informed judgements

Duty of Loyalty: Board members are required to be faithful to the Chamber, avoiding conflicts of interest.

Duty of Obedience: Board members must ensure that the Chamber complies with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations as well as the Chamber's governing documents. Members should also remain committed to the established mission of the Chamber of Commerce.

Make knowledge-based decisions

Attend at least 60% of Chamber events (as their schedule/job allows)

- These include ribbon-cuttings, groundbreaking ceremonies, Business After Hours, etc.

Assist in membership activities

Support the decisions of the board
